The Grant County Snowballers along with the Sumpter, Unity, and Burns Clubs will host rides during the week of January 19. All rides leave the Grant County Fairgrounds by **9:00 AM** each day.

Because of the many miles of groomed snowmobile trails in Grant County, covering all kinds of terrain, there will be a multiple of rides going all different directions each day. Each morning, at the Fairgrounds, you will pick your ride leader for the area or riding level preferred.

The main thing we want is to separate the extreme riders from the beginners. The extreme rides are just that, we do not want to get anyone in over their head. It will be a great time for everyone.
